

Library Park Master Plan

A. Accessible Parking, Drop-off, and Pathway to Entrance

1. Increased existing parking lot by 3 spaces, including a dedicated ADA-compliant spot
2. Specified drop-off area with access aisle
3. Accessible pathway to the main entrance, which also helps connect the new parking area to the classroom spaces throughout the library grounds

B. Learning Garden Classroom

1. Expanded outdoor classroom area that includes 6 new accessible picnic tables for hands-on crafts and projects
2. Four raised bed learning gardens and a composting station which will further education about the library's green initiatives

C. Program & Gathering Space

1. Inviting space with surrounding garden beds
2. New outdoor chairs and tables for informal gatherings

D. Portico Program Space

1. Repositioned blue stone pavers to provide an improved plaza for events at the original entrance, utilizing the existing covered portico

E. Program and Gathering Space, with an Accessible Path

1. Existing gathering area to be enlarged to create an inviting space for groups
2. Six new benches with a hedge screening
3. Expanded outdoor wi-fi access
4. The library's mission is extended into the outdoor spaces

F. New Entry (Future Phase)

1. As funding permits, develop an enlarged exterior entry that celebrates the architecture of the building
2. Create an open entry plaza and expanded staircase that provides a welcoming entryway
